PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

❖ CLASSES 2018

Our Kindergarten students have quickly settled into the school and have been enjoying their learning experiences in the classroom. Many happy faces have been visible – students, parents and teachers alike!

This week, we are still waiting to finalise some of our class numbers as we await for a few students to return for 2018 but it would appear that we will remain with our current 14 x class structure for 2018.

❖ **K – 6 ASSEMBLIES**

- c. On the Kegworth Public School website;
- d. Minimal hard copies available on the newsstand near the front office.

Please be advised that:

- The school newsletter will continue to be emailed out to the parent community and will also be available on the Skoolbag app and school website each week.
Kindergarten parents and caregivers will also receive a hard copy of the Newsletter until contact email addresses have been included on the school's email distribution list.
- School Bytes (student invoice accounts) will continue to be emailed out to the parent community during each term.
- Class or year group printed hard copies will not be sent home.

Parents and caregivers are requested to provide any updated contact email details to the school and are encouraged to regularly check the Skoolbag app for events relating to their child.

If you have not yet uploaded the "Skoolbag" app to your phone, an instruction flyer has been included for your information.

❖ **WORKBOOKS & STUDENT ACCOUNTS 2018**

Just a reminder that all workbooks need to be paid online via the LJ Harper's website. Detailed information has once again been included in this week's Newsletter for your reference.

Please be advised:

- Payment is made directly to the supplier.
- The front office cannot pay on behalf of students – please do not send any work book payments to the front office.
- Closing date for all online payments is **Tuesday 13 February.**
- Delivering of paid book packs for each student each student is on **Wednesday 14 February.**
- Be advised that students will not receive their backpack unless payment has been received by the supplier.
- All teachers and students will begin using workbooks beginning Week 4.

If you do not have access to the internet, please contact the school front office where we may be able to assist you.

Details regarding additional student account payments including annual school contributions, literacy and visual arts resource payments will be forwarded shortly to parents and caregivers. These will also appear on your child's 2018 invoice account.

Payment for these can be made directly to the school via the POP process, EFTPOS or cash at the school front office.

Another copy of "Student Essentials - 2018" will be available on Skoolbag for your information. Thank you to those parents and caregivers who have already provided these items. It is essential that each student brings these requirements as soon as possible so that they can be used as part of their formal learning.

❖ **SCHOOL PARKING and SAFETY**

Leichhardt Council have begun work on repairing the redundant driveway and uneven footpath just outside our Kegworth Street gates leading down towards the sport court, as of this morning.

This will mean that our Kiss and Drop Zone will be out of action for a number of days for the morning and afternoon sessions. Pedestrian access to this area will also be impacted.

Once this area has been completed, the footpath on the other side of Kegworth Street gates will also be removed and replaced (look for the yellow markings to identify work areas). This will impact on cars wishing to park in the 5 minute parking zones. It is anticipated that all work should be completed by mid next week (weather permitting).

Parents, caregivers and students are asked to pay particular attention to variations in this area to ensure student safety during this time. Your cooperation is appreciated.

FOR PARENTS and CAREGIVERS

For iPhone and iPad users:

1. Go to the "App Store".
2. Type your school name in the search (using a suburb name will help).
3. You will see your school appear, click "Get", then "Install".
4. The app is FREE to download.
5. When installed, click to open.
6. Select "OK" to receive push notifications when asked.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

For Android Users:

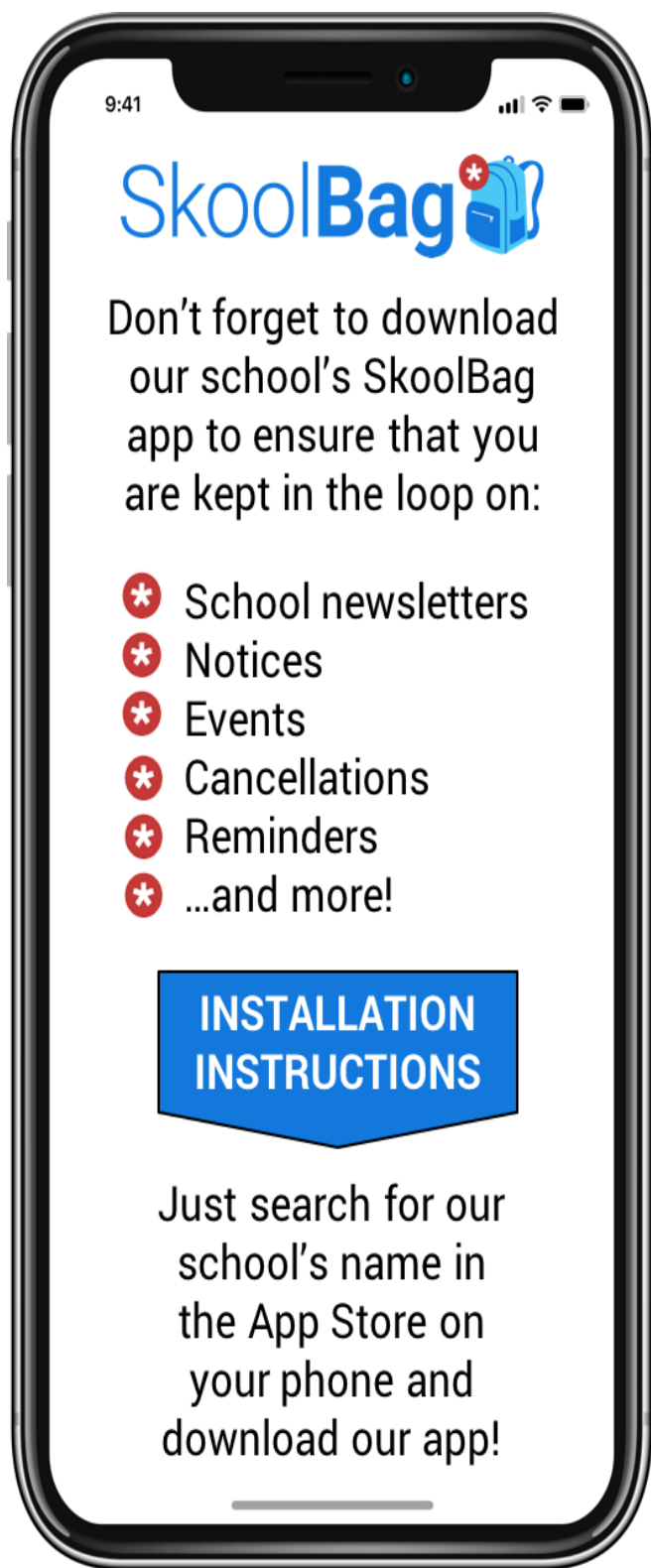
You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
2. Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using suburb name will help.
3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
4. Click the "Install" button.
5. Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
6. Click "Open" when installed.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch

Please Note: Some brands of Android phones need the setting in "Notification Manager" changed to "Allow" instead of "Notify" in order for the push notifications to work. The phone must also be running at least version 4 system software to run the app.

For Windows 8.1 Phone and Windows 8.1 or 10 device users:

1. Go to the Windows Store on your 8.1 Windows Phone or Windows 8.1/10 Device
2. Search for "Skoolbag" in the keyword app search
3. Install the Skoolbag app
4. Find your school either by using the keyword search or location service.
5. Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen.
6. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
7. Toggle the Push Categories that are applicable to you by tapping the on/off switch.

ETHICS CLASSES AT KEGWORTH PUBLIC SCHOOL

Could you be an **ethics coordinator** or an **ethics teacher** for Kegworth?

Our current ethics coordinator and one of our ethics teachers are moving on at the end of this year and we are seeking volunteers so that classes can continue next year. Ethics classes began at Kegworth in 2012 and are currently available for children in classes from grade 2 to grade 6.

The ethics coordinator communicates with school staff, supports ethics teachers and liaises with Primary Ethics, the not-for-profit organisation approved to design curriculum and training for the program.

This role provides a great opportunity for a working parent who might be unable to volunteer during school hours and is a rewarding way to engage with the school community. Times are flexible, requiring approximately 1 hour per week. Online training is provided.

Ethics teachers receive full training by Primary Ethics, the not-for-profit organisation approved to design curriculum and training for the ethics program. Training consists of a two day workshop and short online modules. Lesson materials are provided. Suitable volunteers have an interest in children's education and development of critical thinking skills and must be available at 2:45pm on Thursday afternoons each week.

In ethics classes, children learn how to think logically, disagree respectfully and support their arguments with evidence, rather than act according to blind habit or peer pressure.

Children discuss topics such as:

- imagining how others feel
- how do we treat living things?
- what is laziness?
- how do we disagree in a respectful way?
- fairness
