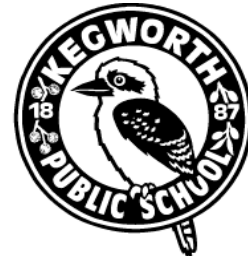

  - ✓ Cellophane from bunches of flowers (cut into A3 size pieces)
  - ✓ Cereal box liners
  - ✓ Chip and cracker packets (silver lined)
  - ✓ Chocolate and snack bar wrappers
  - ✓ Cling Wrap - free of food residue
  - ✓ Confectionery bags
  - ✓ Dry pet food bags
  - ✓ Fresh produce bags
  - ✓ Frozen food bags
  - ✓ Green bags (Polypropylene Bags)
  - ✓ Ice cream wrappers
  - ✓ Large sheets of plastic that furniture comes wrapped in (cut into A3 size pieces)
  - ✓ Netting produce bags (any metal clips removed)
  - ✓ Newspaper and magazine wrap
  - ✓ Pasta bags
  - ✓ Plastic Australia Post satchels
  - ✓ Plastic carrier bags from all stores
  - ✓ Plastic film wrap from grocery items such as nappies and toilet paper
  - ✓ Plastic sachets
  - ✓ Potting mix and compost bags - both the plastic and woven polypropylene types (cut into A3 size pieces and free of as much product as possible)
  - ✓ Rice bags - both plastic and the woven type (if large, cut into A3 size pieces)
  - ✓ Snap lock bags / zip lock bags
  - ✓ Squeeze pouches with lid on (e.g. yogurt/baby food)
  - ✓ Wine bladders - clear plastic ones only
- Please make sure your plastic is dry and as empty as possible.

# Applications to enrol in a NSW Government Pre-School

## **“Wait List” applications are now open for 2020 Kegworth Pre-School!**

Parents and caregivers who are seeking enrolment in the Pre-School for 2020 are requested to complete a “Wait List” application which is then required to be returned to the school office, as soon as possible.

Please note:

- That the “Wait List” application is only an expression of interest and does not imply that you will be successful in gaining a placement. Each year we have far more applications than positions available;
- According to the ‘National Partnership Agreement on Early Childhood Education’, every child, 12 months prior to full time schooling, will have access to a Pre-School program for 15 hours per week, 40 weeks a year. This will ensure that the Pre-School program is equitable for ALL children.
- Currently we offer 2 x programs – “Kangaroos” and “Koalas”

With this option, 2 days remain constant with both programs, i.e: Monday AND Tuesday - “Kangaroos”, or Thursday AND Friday – “Koalas”. There would then be the alternating Wednesday each fortnight between both programs.

- All “Wait List” applications must be submitted in person or by mail to the main school office.

Following lodgement of the waiting list application, during August to September 2019, you will be contacted with either:

- an offer of placement **OR**
- a notification that you are currently unsuccessful and have been placed on a waiting list.

Before your child starts Pre-School with us, we will need to sight and take a copy of:

- original birth certificate and or passport AND
- recent immunisation details

Your child must turn 4 years of age by 31 July the year they start Pre-School. Pre-School placements are for **one year only** – being the year before they start Kindergarten. If your child was born mid-year, please consider carefully the year you would like them to attend Pre-School.

If you have any further enquiries regarding our Pre-School or you would like help completing the waiting list application, our administrative staff are available to assist you. Please do not hesitate to contact the main school office on ph: 9569 7320.

2019 is going to be a big year in ethics education for children in NSW public primary schools. And it needs to be: Our children are growing up in a world of ethical challenges that have never been seen before.

Primary Ethics classes help to build children's abilities to navigate the ethical complexities of life, to think critically and to make well-reasoned decisions that are considerate of the impacts on those around them.

With streamlined information and enrolment procedures now in place for when school goes back next week, and more than 20 new ethics teacher training sessions around the state to kick off our year, the capacity to offer ethics classes to our children from K-6 is only limited by two things:

- Donations to fund recruitment, training, curriculum resources and volunteer support
- Volunteers who are available for an hour a week to deliver the classes

# ILLEGAL PARKING PUTS CHILDREN'S LIVES AT RISK



Children are small, harder to see, behave unpredictably and are extremely vulnerable. They need **YOU** to take extra care when driving and parking around school zones.



## No Parking

No waiting. You have 2 minutes to drop-off or pick-up. You must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle.



## No Stopping

You must not stop on a length of road with a No Stopping sign. The first 10m from an intersection is a no stopping zone. Yellow kerb lines are also No Stopping zones.



## Bus Zone

Only a public bus can stop in a bus zone.



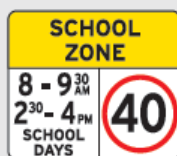
## Mobile Phones

Extra fines apply for using mobile phones in a school zone.

## Speeding Offences



40km/h is the limit. Children are vulnerable, so slow down in school zones.



May be subject to Double Demerits

## Pedestrian Crossings

1. In a queue of traffic, no part of your vehicle can stop on a pedestrian crossing.
2. Do not let your child in or out of a vehicle at a pedestrian crossing as this is a No Stopping zone.



## Driveways & Footpaths

Do not park on or across a driveway or footpath.



## U turns

Illegal on or near a pedestrian crossing and across double white lines.



## Double Parking

Double parking is illegal and is very dangerous in a school zone.
