❖ ENROLMENTS FOR 2020

Enrolments for both Kegworth Preschool and Kindergarten 2020 are now open. Prospective parents and students for any student intending to enrol in any year group in 2020, are invited to attend our **Open Morning on Thursday 27 June**, from 9:30am starting in the school's Assembly Hall and concluding with a school tour guided by our Stage 3 students.

Please spread the word to your family and friends about our open Morning or just collect an enrolment form from the school front office. Please don't wait – complete your enrolment to secure your child's place now.

❖ STUDENT ATTENDANCE – EXEMPTIONS

I have recently received a number of requests from parents and caregivers asking for approval for their child / children to leave school early on a weekly basis to attend either swimming, dance or music programs.

Please be aware under the Department's guidelines for attendance that early departure approval for such reasons will not be approved, only unless the request complies with the following criteria, as outlined below:

- A. Students who participate in the entertainment industry, elite arts or elite sporting grams who are required to attend regular activities / training during school time. Supporting documentation will need to be provided by parents prior to an exemption being approved.
- B. Students who participate in school based programs including behaviour management transition programs.
- C. Students who require part day exemption due to the requirements of a health care plan. Consultation and communication between the school, parents and health care professionals will need to be undertaken.

In each of these circumstances, parents and caregivers are required to complete and submit an *"Application for Exemption from Attendance / Enrolment at School"*, prior to commencing the program.

Parents and caregivers cannot just assume that regular early departure from school to attend another program is acceptable. Partial attendance, which includes early departure and / or late arrival, are recorded against your child's attendance record as "unjustified" in this situation. A significant number of unjustified absences recorded on your child's record may result in school reviews and / or conversations undertaken with you, the school and / or the Home School Liaison Officer.

❖ BUSH TUCKER GARDEN – OPENING CEREMONY

Our Stage 2 students, Ms Radburn and Mr Plowman have been working tirelessly over the past weeks, getting our Bush Tucker Garden ready for this very important occasion to take place during National Reconciliation Week. We invite you, our parent community to join us in the top playground (near the Music Hall) for our official opening on **Friday 31 May from 9:30am**, which will include a traditional Aboriginal Acknowledgement to Country and smoking ceremony, finishing with a light morning tea which will include modern aboriginal biscuits, scones and banana bread. ILLEGAL PARKING PUTS CHILDREN'S LIVES AT RISK



Children are small, harder to see, behave unpredictably and are extremely vulnerable. They need **YOU** to take extra care when driving and parking around school zones.



No Parking

No waiting. You have 2 minutes to drop-off or pick-up. You must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle.



Pedestrian Crossings

1. In a queue of traffic, no part of your vehicle can stop on a pedestrian crossing.
2. Do not let your child in or out of a vehicle at a pedestrian crossing as this is a No Stopping zone.



No Stopping

You must not stop on a length of road with a No Stopping sign. The first 10m from an intersection is a no stopping zone. Yellow kerb lines are also No Stopping zones.



Driveways & Footpaths

Do not park on or across a driveway or footpath.



Bus Zone

Only a public bus can stop in a bus zone.



U turns

Illegal on or near a pedestrian crossing and across double white lines.



Mobile Phones

Extra fines apply for using mobile phones in a school zone.



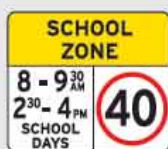
