PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

❖ **NATIONALLY CONSISTENT COLLECTION of DATA on SCHOOL STUDENTS with DISABILITY (NCCD)**

Every year around this time, all schools in Australia participate in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD). The NCCD process requires schools to identify information already available in the school about supports provided to students who identify as having a disability. These relate to legislative requirements under the Disability Discrimination Act (1992) and the Disability Standards For Education (2005) in line with NCCD guidelines (2019). Student information provided includes:

- Year of schooling;

- Category of disability – physical, cognitive, sensory or social /emotional;
- Level of adjustment provided within the quality differentiated teaching practice – categorised as either: supplementary, substantial or extensive.

The information provided, assists our school to:

- Formally recognise the support and adjustments provided to students with the disability in schools;
- Consider how best they can strengthen the support of students with disability in schools;
- Develop shared practices so that they can review their learning programs in order to improve educational outcomes for students with disability;

The NCCD provides information to state and federal governments so that they are able to plan more broadly for the support of students with a disability. Information collected by the NCCD will have no direct impact on your child and your child will not be involved in any testing process. The school will provide data to the Australian Government in such a way that no child will be able to be identified- the privacy & confidentiality of all student information is ensured. All information is protected by privacy laws that regulate the collection, storage and disclosure of personal information. ILLEGAL PARKING PUTS CHILDREN'S LIVES AT RISK



Children are small, harder to see, behave unpredictably and are extremely vulnerable. They need YOU to take extra care when driving and parking around school zones.



No Parking

No waiting. You have 2 minutes to drop-off or pick-up. You must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle.



Pedestrian Crossings

1. In a queue of traffic, no part of your vehicle can stop on a pedestrian crossing.
2. Do not let your child in or out of a vehicle at a pedestrian crossing as this is a No Stopping zone.



No Stopping

You must not stop on a length of road with a No Stopping sign. The first 10m from an intersection is a no stopping zone. Yellow kerb lines are also No Stopping zones.



Driveways & Footpaths

Do not park on or across a driveway or footpath.



Bus Zone

Only a public bus can stop in a bus zone.



U turns

Illegal on or near a pedestrian crossing and across double white lines.



Mobile Phones

Extra fines apply for using mobile phones in a school zone.



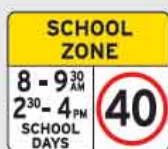
