★ STAFF CHANGES

Some staffing updates for your information:

- We welcome Ms Mona Farah to Kegworth this year. Ms Farah is a permanent teacher at Kegworth but was permitted to undertake a 'higher duties teaching position' at Mattraville Public School over the past 3 years. We are thrilled to finally have Ms Farah join us this year at our school!
- Miss Lisa Coelho is filling the position left by Mr Warren Arthur, who after a period of leave, elected to retire at the end of 2019. The school is aiming to have this teaching position held over for the remainder of this year, pending further discussions and a decision with the DoE Human Resources and the School Director. More information to come as it arises. Miss Coelho will be coordinating the school's Beginner Recorder Ensemble (Years 1 & 2) and the Kookaburra Choir (Years 1 & 2) with Miss Marafioti.
- Ms Laura Watkins is employed temporarily in the role of class teacher for a Year 5-6 class, filling the permanent position vacated last year by Carmelina Maiorana (Ferro). This position is a temporary teacher engagement. The school is waiting to receive direction from DoE Human Resources as to whether this placement will be filled externally by a permanent teacher or whether approval can be given to undertake the merit selection process to fill this position. More information around this position is yet to come.
- Miss Jessica Marafioti and Ms Kristy Williams remain as temporary class teachers on K-Green and 2W respectively for 2020, filling school teacher entitlement positions for this year.
- Ms Pauline Findlay returns in a fulltime capacity undertaking the role of K – 6 Music and Visual Arts Specialist teacher. Our timetable has provided for all K – 6 students to be taught music curriculum weekly this year. The Visual Arts program will be taught on a term basis to all K – 6 students. Ms Findlay will also be coordinating the school's biannual Art Show in Term 3 as well as coordinating the school's Primary Choir and Senior Recorder Ensemble.
- Ms Maria Wilson will continue in her specialist teaching role for History (Years 4 – 6) and Digital Technologies (Years 1 – 6) in the school's Learning Hub and Library
- Ms Catherine Mazzeo continues in her specialist role as our Community Language Program (CLP) teacher for Years Kindergarten to Year 3 only. Her role will also include History curriculum for Years K – 3 students.

- Mr John Galea returns as our EAL/D (English and Language Dialect teacher) and LaST (Learning and Support teacher) for 4 days per week – Monday – Wednesday & Fridays. Mr Galea is replacing Mr Raymond Hope (permanent LaST teacher) who is currently on leave until the end of this year.
- Mrs Carole Green will be working 4 days per week (Tues – Thurs) and will undertake the role of Literacy Support teacher, predominately working with Early Stage 1 (Kindergarten) and Stage 1 (Years 1 & 2) classes.

★ **QUERIES OR CONCERNS**

Should you have any concerns, questions, or queries during the year, please remember that your child's teacher is the first person to contact. If they are unavailable, please ask for the Assistant Principal and in cases that are extremely urgent, please don't hesitate to contact the office and make an appointment to see me.

Please keep in mind, that all teachers including Assistant Principals have a teaching load so it is best to make contact either via email, phone or in person at the school front office where the relevant information will be passed onto the appropriate personnel.

Our Assistant Principals are responsible for overseeing each stage group, as listed below:

- Early Stage 1 (Kindergarten) and Stage 1 (Years 1 & 2) – Mrs Carole Green (Tuesday - Friday) & Mrs Josie Giardina (Mondays);
- Stage 2 (Years 3 & 4) – Ms Lisa Williams
- Stage 3 (Years 5 & 6) – Mr Philip Toovey

★ **SCHOOL ROUTINES**

A reminder for parents and caregivers as to the procedures for late arrival and early departure of students for all K – 6 students:

- The school operates on an electronic roll system;
- Class teachers will continue to mark student attendance in the classrooms and submit this electronically to the front office;
- Students, accompanied by parents and caregivers, who are late to school (arrival after morning assembly) or require to leave early can only sign out from the school front office;
- Class teachers do not have the ability to change any information regarding student attendance electronically.

These include:

• **EARLY DEPARTURES:**

- Parent & caregivers to come to front office for sign out;
- Office staff to contact class teacher by phone to request for child to come to front office, with school bag. Parents and caregivers to wait for student in front foyer;
- Parents and caregivers & student leave school together from front office area.

• **LATE ARRIVALS:**

- Parent & caregivers to come to front office for sign in;
- Student walks independently to classroom (or in the event of younger students will be escorted by office staff, if required);
- Parents and caregivers do not walk to the classroom with student;
- Parents and caregivers leave school from front office area.

★ **STUDENT NOTES & FORMS**

Clear communication of school processes to parents and caregivers are essential. Written school communication, including permission notes for excursions and incursions, will be provided through the following means only:

- a. in PDF, forwarded on the skoolbag app;
- b. in 'e-form', on the skoolbag app (where parents & caregivers are required to respond);
- c. minimal hard copies available on the Newsstand, near the front office.

Please be advised that:

- The school newsletter will continue to be emailed out to the parent community and will also be available on the Skoolbag app and school website each fortnight.
- School Bytes (student invoice accounts) will continue to be emailed out to the parent community in Week 5 and are due to be paid by Week 8 of each term.
- Class or year group printed hard copies of permission notes will not be sent home.

Parents and caregivers are requested to ensure that they keep their contact email details up to date with the school and are encouraged to regularly check the Skoolbag app for updates relating to events for their child.

★ **SKOOLBAG COMMUNICATION**

Parents and carers are asked to check the Skoolbag app to ensure that they are enrolled in the correct content year group for 2020.

This will ensure that you receive specific information for your year group only, when it sent out on Skoolbag.

If your child attended Kegworth Preschool in 2019 and is now enrolled in Kindergarten in 2020 – you will need to change your content group to “Kindergarten – 2020”. The old Pre-School 2019 content group will be deleted as of Monday 17 February 2020.

Any newly enrolled parents and caregivers are encouraged to download the Skoolbag app as soon as possible. All school information is communicated via this app. Instructions as to how to access the app is included in this Newsletter.

★ **STUDENT WORKBOOKS**

Online student workbook ordering has now closed. Thank you to the many parents and caregivers who completed this process before the start of this school year. All student workbooks are being delivered to the school on Tuesday 4 February so that students can begin using these books as soon as possible.

Please be advised that if you did not make payment directly to the supplier for your child's workbooks, the school will be invoicing the outstanding value onto your child's student invoice account.

Details regarding additional student account payments including annual school contributions, literacy and visual arts resource payments will be forwarded shortly to parents and caregivers. These will also appear on your child's 2020 invoice account. Payment for these can be made directly to the school via the POP process, EFTPOS or cash at the school front office.

Another copy of “Student Essentials - 2020” has been included in this Newsletter, for your information. Thank you to those parents and caregivers who have already provided these. It would be appreciated if each student could bring these requirements into school, as soon as possible.

★ **2020 STAFF DEVELOPMENT DAYS**

This year there will be a minor change to our regular Staff Development Day – Pupil Free Days which will impact on student start day in Term 3 and the final student day at the end of the school year.

★ **UNIFORM SHOP**

Our Uniform Shop is open on relevant dates as advertised in the Newsletter from 2:45 – 3:30pm for any uniform purchases. Should you need some uniform requirements, please do not hesitate to complete the uniform form and deposit your request in the letter box with payment or use the school's flexi school online ordering system. Information can be found outside of the uniform shop or on the newsstand near the front office.

★ **SCHOOL CANTEEN**

The school canteen has reopened for lunch orders and over the counter sales at lunchtime only. The Flexischools system for lunch orders is the preferred method. However, should you require to order of a morning, the manual paper bag method is still available.

Kindergarten parents & carers are asked not to provide money to their children for over the counter sales for the first 4 weeks of the school term until our Kindergarten students have settled in and are better orientated to school routines.

A copy of the 2020 Canteen menu has been included for your information.

★ **SCHOOL PARKING**

Please ensure that you follow and adhere to all street signage around the perimeter of the school.

Signage for our “Kiss and Drop Zone” is quite visible.

- Please ensure that your child is aware that you will be collecting them from this area;
- Tell your child to come to the Kegworth street gates straight away upon dismissal, to wait for you along with the duty teacher (some students tend to play with their friends in the playground and will assume that you will come into the school to collect them, if you don't remind them).
- Your child should then be waiting to quickly get into your car when you pull up in this area.



Conditions for this area are as follows:

- Parking in this area is for 2 minutes only
- Stay in your car
- Penalties apply - \$180 and 2 demerit points
- Kiss and Drop operates from 8:30 – 9:30am - school mornings and 3:00 – 4:00pm – school afternoons

If you are waiting in this area and have exceeded the 2 minute wait:

- Please be considerate to other parents and caregivers and move out of the allocated space
- Drive around the block - no doubt your child will be waiting for you at the gate once you have come around again

Please note that the “P5min” parking along Kegworth Street towards Tebbutt Street, is still available for those parents and caregivers who would prefer to park and assist their child / children to and from their cars, in and out of the school grounds.

Should there be a requirement for parents and caregivers to be at school longer than a 5 minute period, it is recommended that parking be obtained further along Kegworth Street or in Lords Road, as appropriate.

Parents and caregivers are reminded **NOT TO DOUBLE PARK** in Kegworth Street – this is illegal and compromises the safety of all members of the school community.

The school regularly contacts Leichardt Council and the local police who will patrol these areas during peak times of a morning and afternoon to ensure that parents and caregivers are following specific road and parking requirements. It has not been uncommon for parents and caregivers to be fined as a result.



★ **BAND and STRING PROGRAMS**

Organisation is currently being put in place for extra-curricular Music programs to begin.

All music tuition has started this week for any student who is participating in the school's Music Band and / or String programs.

Rehearsals for Senior & Junior Strings and Senior Band will begin as of Monday 10 February. Junior Band students will begin rehearsals on Monday 17 February. Please see further information in the Newsletter.

Our first **Music Committee Meeting will take place on Monday 3 February 2020**, beginning at 6:30pm in the school staffroom.

★ **KEGWORTH NEWSLETTER**

Kindergarten students will receive a hard copy of the Weeks 2 & 3 Newsletter only until the administration office has created the Kindergarten email distribution list.

To ensure that you receive this information, please advise the school front office, should there be any changes to your email account details. Parents and caregivers are to be advised that all Newsletters are sent as a PDF file. It is essential that all parents and caregivers check their junk mail for the first Newsletter should they not receive it. Parents and caregivers are also advised to regularly clear their email inboxes so that Newsletters do not bounce back as a result.

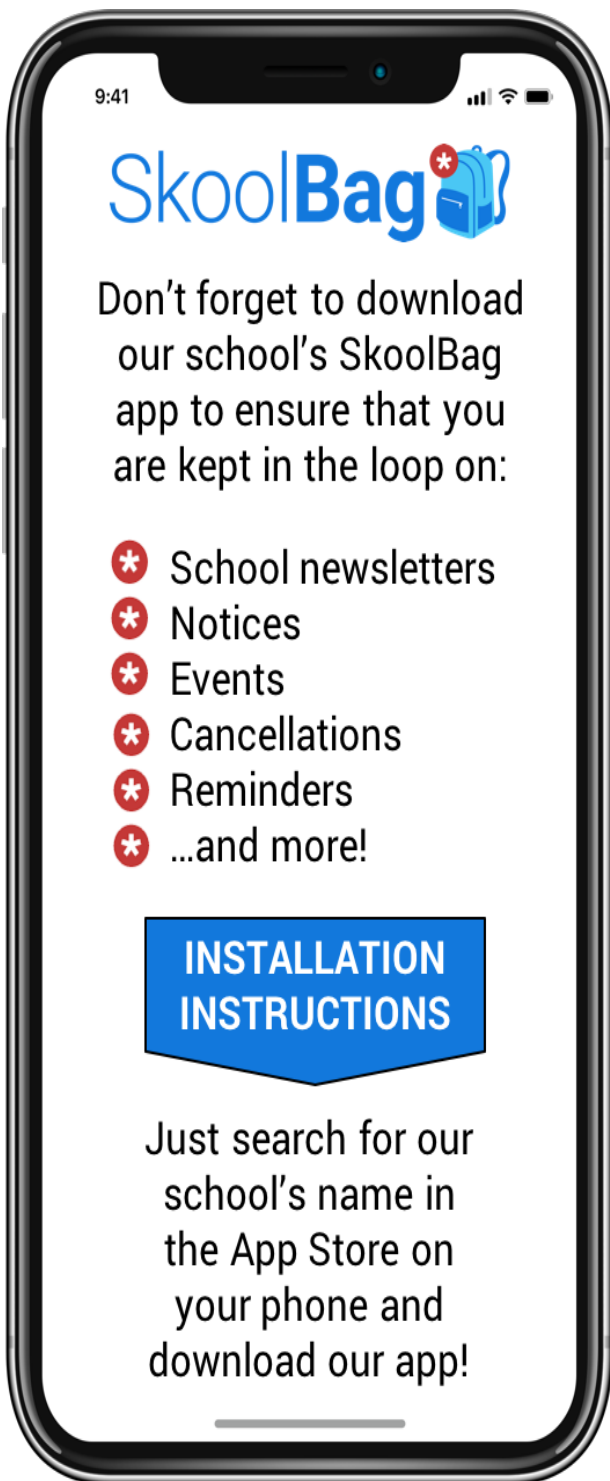

FOR PARENTS and CAREGIVERS

For iPhone and iPad users:

1. Go to the "App Store".
2. Type your school name in the search (using a suburb name will help).
3. You will see your school appear, click "Get", then "Install".
4. The app is FREE to download.
5. When installed, click to open.
6. Select "OK" to receive push notifications when asked.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

For Android Users:

You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
2. Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using suburb name will help.
3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
4. Click the "Install" button.
5. Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
6. Click "Open" when installed.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".

8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch

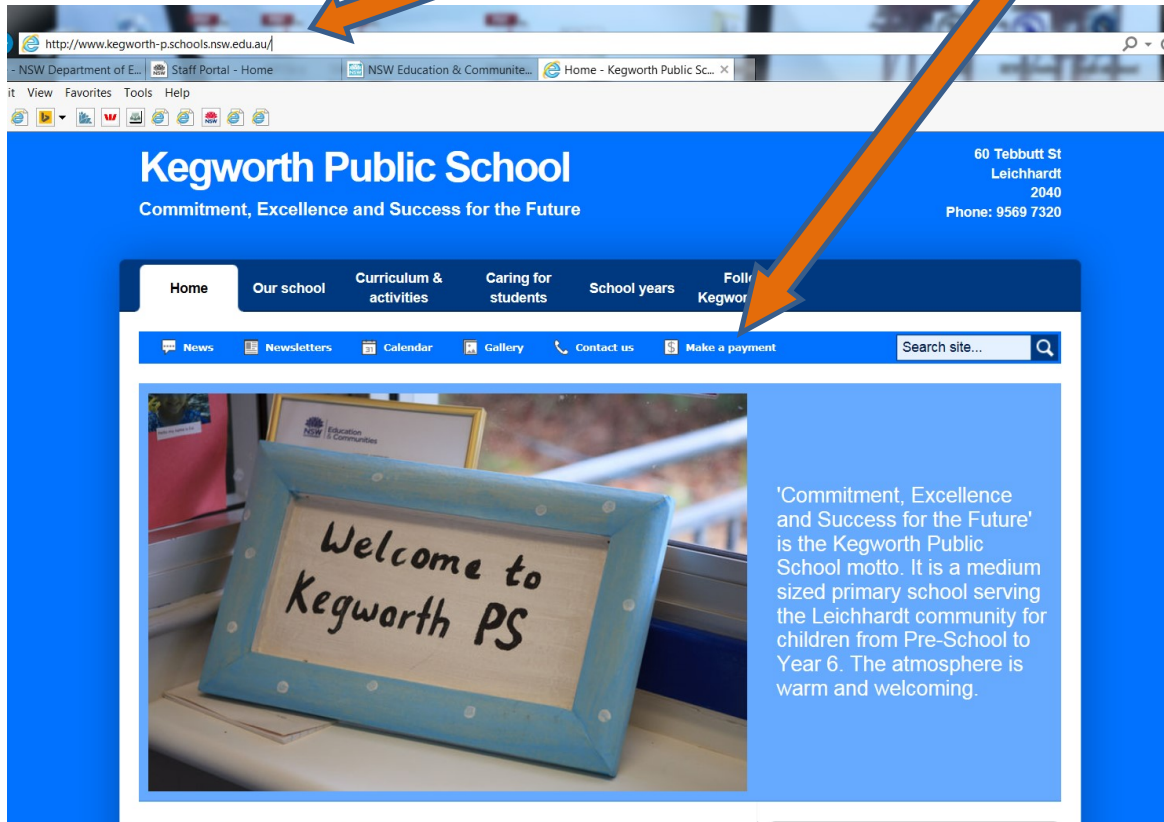
Please Note: Some brands of Android phones need the setting in "Notification Manager" changed to "Allow" instead of "Notify" in order for the push notifications to work. The phone must also be running at least version 4 system software to run the app.

For Windows 8.1 Phone and Windows 8.1 or 10 device users:

1. Go to the Windows Store on your 8.1 Windows Phone or Windows 8.1/10 Device
2. Search for "Skoolbag" in the keyword app search
3. Install the Skoolbag app
4. Find your school either by using the keyword search or location service.
5. Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen.

- ❖ The permission notes (for excursions etc) will have a check box enabling parents to show the online payment receipt number issued by the bank, which must be provided.
- ❖ SRN (Student Reference Number) – you will not require this information in order to process a payment. Please leave this section blank.
- ❖ It will be the responsibility of the parent to keep this receipt, as the school will not be issuing receipts for these online payments. Parents and carers still have the option of coming to our Admin office and using the cash or EFTPOS options.
