#### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Hi Everyone, I've been chatting with our P&C, Music Committee, office staff and teachers about the amount/frequency of Skoolbag notifications that have been going out. It seems to me that it has been difficult to get the balance right between keeping all our families completely informed & updated & barraging phones and email accounts with constant messages. I'm calling it "Skoolbag-Fatigue", what has been well intentioned communication has at times been just too much. Over the next few weeks, we'll work together to come up with a more consistent & predictable system of sending out notifications to families in an attempt to find a happy medium. In the interim, please bear with us & I'll be in touch when we have some type of solution. In terms of our newsletter, "The Kegworth Post", we will send it out every Friday in odd weeks.

Parent/Teacher Interviews are planned for weeks 10 & 11 of this term. This is a chance for you to meet with your child's teacher and discuss their progress and learning needs. # PREMIER'S BACK TO SCHOOL NSW VOUCHERS

As we prepare for another year of learning in 2023, you can now apply for the Premier's Back to School NSW Program, offering \$150 worth of vouchers (3 x \$50) to help pay for school supplies like school uniforms, shoes, bags, textbooks and stationery.

Every primary and secondary school student in NSW is eligible for the vouchers.

Vouchers must be used before 30 June 2023.

Please read the letter from the Premier about the program and the vouchers.

You can apply for and access your vouchers in your MyServiceNSW account, in the Service NSW app, by calling Service NSW on 137788 or by visiting your local Service Centre https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/service-centre

To be eligible, your child needs to be a NSW resident and enrolled in a NSW primary or secondary school in NSW in 2023.

Children in Years 2 to 6 are invited to join JUNIOR BAND.

Band program instruments are clarinet, flute, oboe, saxophone, trombone, trumpet, baritone, French horn, bass guitar, drum/percussion and keyboard.

Children in any year are invited to join JUNIOR STRINGS.

String ensemble instruments are violin, viola, cello, and double bass.

String students first complete one term (10 x weeks) of private lessons on their chosen instrument, after which they may join the String Ensemble.
